Memorial Service Procession: Shorty was a longtime member and officer of the Southern Cruiser's Riding Club (SCRC), Port City Chapter 162 along with being a very active and respected biker within the state and local motorcycle community. As a result, his funeral service is expected to be well attended and will involve a funeral procession from his home in Leland, NC to the funeral home in Wilmington, NC, which may involve several hundred motorcycles and other vehicles. A sheriff/police escort has been approved and will be provided with officers to assist with traffic control during the procession.

Current and past members of the SCRC are requested to arrive no later than 1:15 pm at the Kangaroo Convenience Store in Murrayville - 2400 North College Rd, Wilmington NC 28405. Pre-ride briefing will be at 1:30 pm with Kickstands up (KSU) and departing promptly at 1:40 pm. We will ride as a group to Shorty's home (approx. 13 miles) where we will stage for escorting the family to the funeral home. Departure of procession from Shorty's home will be promptly at 2:30 pm. *Biker attire with club vest is preferred!*

Other bikes/motorcycles/trikes and friends (non-SCRC Members) are requested to arrive no later than 2:00 pm for staging located at: *Riverwalk Park – 580 River Rd SE, Leland, NC 28451, which is across the street from Belville Elementary School on NC133.* The procession will leave Shorty's home promptly at 2:30 pm then travel through and exit the Olde Towne neighborhood turning left onto NC133. It would then pass by the Riverwalk Park where the other motorcycles/participants that are staged would join in the procession behind the family vehicles as the group passes by and then proceed directly to the funeral home (approx. 12 miles).
